You may also notice it in the toilet or on the surface of the stool. Some other symptoms include itching as this kind of hemorrhoid leaks mucus that is highly irritating. Discomfort is a common feeling as the bulge from the piles makes one feel the urge to need to have a bowel movement despite the fact that they do not. Pain is the least of the common symptoms when it comes to this kind of hemorrhoids. The only time that these piles are agonizing will be when they bulge out of the anus and are exposed.
