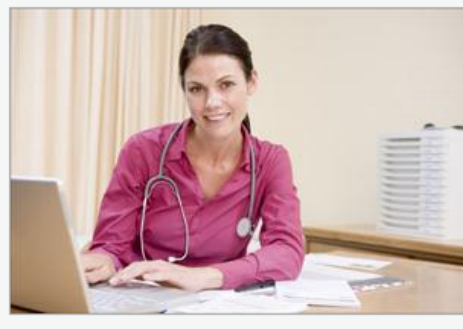


# Stop Itchy Hemorrhoids: Hemorrhoidectomy for Hemorrhoids-All You need to Know

Exercise and other physical activities including walking and jogging, and eating a high fibre diet, help reduce constipation. Good sources of fibre are fruits, vegetables, and whole grains that will help to keep your bowels regular and minimizing the pressure and straining of constipation in your daily life.

- Warm tub baths several times a day in plain, warm water for about 10 minutes is a good idea.
- Preventing of the recurrence of hemorrhoids will require relieving the pressure and straining of constipation.
- Doctors will often recommend increasing fibre and water or fluids in the diet.
- Eating the right amount of fibre and drinking six to eight glasses of water/fluid can lead to lessens pressure on hemorrhoids caused by straining.

*“ Hemorrhoidectomy for hemorrhoids is done by first applying anaesthesia to the patient, either by general anaesthesia where the patient is knocked out, spinal anaesthesia where the patient will feel numb from the waist down, or the local anaesthesia where the latter is injected on the affected portion. After that, the medical process of cutting off the hemorrhoid is executed. This is, of course, going to be stitched and applied with antibiotics. It sounded easy, but there are a lot of side effects to be able to this process as you may end up not being able to urinate well for several days and may also be afflicted by urinary infection.*

As a surgical procedure, a hemorrhoidectomy is proven to be effective and is a long-term solution for the condition. ## Also, Itching can Occur as Well as Extreme Pain that is Located Around the Anus Area

This happens when the swollen veins become prolapsed and it can protrude especially when there is a blood clot. - There are two types of Hemorrhoids widely known, which can appear both internally and externally of the anus.
- Internal hemorrhoids occur when there is too much pressure on the internal hemorrhoidal veins.
- The only sign that internal hemorrhoids exist is bright-red blood that appears frequently in the toilet bowl or on the toilet paper.
- Pain is not usually common with internal hemorrhoids, unless a blood clot forms or an infection occurs.
- The external hemorrhoidal veins around the anus can also become swollen, causing external hemorrhoids.
- The coagulation method is where a physician will use an infrared machine to solidify the red blood clots in the hemorrhoid.
- It requires visiting the hospital daily to maximize the results.
- It may take about two months to treat the illness.

An internal hemorrhoid, may protrude through the anus outside the body, becoming irritated and painful. This is known as a protruding hemorrhoid. Internal hemorrhoids, which lie inside the rectum, usually have no symptoms and also therefore the patient may not be aware they have these as they do not generally cause any discomfort.
